

WATERFRONT HISTORY, INDUSTRY, INFRASTRUCTURE

Our tour programs explore the past and present of how New Yorkers live, work, and play along the waterfront. Brooklyn Navy Yard Tours go inside this former naval shipbuilding facility, once one of the world's leading shipyards and today a home for over 450 private businesses in manufacturing, technology, and the arts. Visit the Brooklyn Army Terminal, a gargantuan relic of World War I that is also a city-owned industrial park that supports small manufacturing businesses. Or explore DUMBO, once an industrial neighborhood that is today a thriving arts and commercial district, on our programs with Brooklyn Historical Society.

PROSPECT PARK & URBAN ECOLOGY

Created by Central Park designers Olmsted and Vaux, Prospect Park is an oasis in Brooklyn, and a great site for learning about public lands, forest, water, and wildlife conservation, and NYC history. We also offer nature-themed programs at the Brooklyn Navy Yard, where our tours take a deep look at what's growing in this waterfront industrial park, including oyster restoration and the 1.5-acre Brooklyn Grange Rooftop Farm.
